Key insights of the OECD's activities during the first phase of the RBC-LAC Project




The Project "Promoting Responsible Business Conduct in Latin America and the Caribbean" (RBC-LAC) is financed by and designed in collaboration with the European Union and implemented by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), the International Labour Organization (ILO), and the United Nations Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR).


It was initially a four-year project that started in 2019 and ended in December 2022. Following its success and results, it has been extended for a transitional phase launched in January 2023. A second multi-year phase will start in July 2024.

Below are some highlights of the activities carried out by the OECD during the first phase of the RBC-LAC project in collaboration with LAC Governments, businesses, and other stakeholders, and which led to the development and reinforcement of responsible business practices in the region. These activities included research and analysis, data gathering, technical assistance, peerlearning, capacity-building and training, among others.


